There are many local coffee shops within a few minutes, such as Jericho Coffee Traders, Vaults & Garden opposite the Radcliffe Camera, or a Starbucks at the intersection at the top of the road.

For dinner, Quod is next door to the college and offers upscale pub-food. If you are looking for something more casual but still local, The Bear Inn is a few minutes' walk around the corner and serves English pub classics. This is said to be one of the oldest pubs in Oxford and is known for its large collection of collegiate ties displayed.

The Turf Tavern, accessed through St Helen's Passage on New College Lane, is also a historic Oxford pub that is within 5 minutes' walk of Oriel. Many public figures such as Stephen Hawking and Bill Clinton have visited this pub, and it is frequented by Oxford University and Oxford Brookes University students.

Also on the High Street is Chiang Mai Kitchen, a Thai restaurant visited regularly by our Oxford team, and the Covered Market which is host to many fantastic independent and chain restaurants.
